- 1. BC does not fund events over fall breaks
- 2. No food during outside tournaments

# Requests

- 1. Mens Rugby
  - a. Requested \$810 for ACEMS Coverage for Practice (45\$x18 practices)
    - i. 3 practices a week, six more weeks of practice scheduled
  - b. Not practicing during the week of fall break
  - a. Recommend, second, call, approved
- 2. Outing Club
  - a. Typical membership from CRG is \$75, this semester members are paying for their own memberships
    - i. Some club members are unable to pay for themselves
  - b. Requested \$880: Outing club got subsidized climbing memberships (8 memberships \* 55\$ per month \* 2 months)

  - b. Minji: Is there storage space for this
  - c. RSO: yes at the pool. We are the only team that have water polo suits
  - d. Minji: Are these reusable for years to come?
  - e. RSO: yes
  - f. 700 for gas money reimbursement
    - i. Three tournaments: wesleyan, williams, and bowdoin.
      - 1. Bowdoin: Oct 21-22nd
      - 2. Williams: Oct 14-15th
      - 3. Wesleyan: Oct 7th-8th
    - ii. RSO: The trip to Wesleyan is 57 miles. The trip to Williams is 60 miles, and the trip to Bowdoin is 168 miles. Gas is averaging about \$3.67 a gallon. The Weslayan and Williams tournaments are two day tournaments,

and we plan to drive back to sleep on campus. Therefore, we will be making the drive, there and back, twice. We will probably take 2-3 cars per tournament, depending on the amount of players who want to attend. My calculation is under the assumption that for the entire semester, each driver will use 4 tanks, and I have done the math for two drivers.

- iii. Minji: We only pay \$0.2 per mile, not the actual gallon
- iv. For Bowdoin, RSO will be staying over but for the two other trips RSO will be driving back and forth twice since they will not be staying over
- v. Minji: My calculation per BC policy is lower than this. Can you come back after doing this calculation?

  - i. Minji: The max we can fund for a hotel room is \$175 for four people. Therefore the max we can fund is 1050.
